



PROFESSIONAL ENGLISH III – platform (from a.y. 2022/2023)

Dear students,

The Academic Senate established specific management regarding the registration for the Professional English III (PE3) online exam, expecting a significant number of students.

In particular:

- Registrations for the Professional English exam will close five days before the day of the exam, with no exception;
- Before the exam (approximately the day before), students who have registered for the exam will receive an email with the link to access the online room and the time of the test;
- On the exam day, every student must have their university badge (or an ID document) for identification;
- Once logged in with the link, every student must use IULM credentials and not the personal credentials saved on the device ([here's](#) a tutorial). Students who do not previously log in to Teams with their IULM credentials will not be admitted to the exam;
- Students will receive the result of the written exam by email in the next few days; if they pass the written exam, they will receive the link to access the online room for the oral exam.

In the summer session (May/June/July 2024), there are three exam calls available, 2 of which can be used regardless of the order (e.g. 1° and 2°, 2° and 3°, 1° and 3°):

- 1st call: written exam, Monday, 3rd of June, 2024 (possible continuation on Tuesday, 4th of June, 2024, at 9:00 a.m.); oral exam, Wednesday, 5th of June, 2024 (possible continuation Thursday, 6th of June 2024, at 2:00 p.m.);



- 2nd call: written exam, Monday, 17th of June 2024 (possible continuation, Tuesday, 18th of June 2024, at 9:00 a.m.); oral exam, Wednesday, 19th of June 2024 (possible continuation Thursday, 20th of June 2024, at 2:00 p.m.);
- 3rd call: written exam Monday, 1st of July, 2024 (possible continuation Tuesday, 2nd of July 2024, at 9:00); oral exam, Wednesday, 3rd of July, 2024 (possible continuation Thursday, 4th of July, 9:00).

The Registrar's Office will assign the day and the time according to the registration order. Where possible, registration for other exams scheduled for the same day will be considered during the shift assignments.

For the third exam session (August/September 2024), there are two exam calls, both available for registration as in the fourth session (January/February 2025): exam dates will be published later.

To access QuestionMark, you ought to use a PC (if unable to access through a PC, contact ilc@iulm.it as soon as you register for the exam). QuestionMark is not suitable for tablets and smartphones and could affect the exam. You are not allowed to use earphones, headphones and backgrounds.

WRITTEN EXAM

The written exam will last 75 minutes and is structured as follows:

- Reading (5 questions with 3 multiple-choice answers);
- Cloze (10 missing words, 4 options each);
- Language review (20 sentences to complete with 4 options each);
- Writing (150-200 words);

There are no penalties for incorrect answers.



ORAL EXAM

- **For students who have already obtained oral evaluations during the course** (who do not have to take the oral exam), the email with the result of the written exam will also contain the oral evaluations, which will contribute to the calculation of the final average that will be recorded.
- Please note that oral evaluations obtained during the course will be valid until the fourth session of the a.y. 2023/2024 (January 2025); for this reason, students who do not want to accept the result of the written exam must notify it by email within 24 hours from the publication through the link that will be sent in the email of the results.
- **For students who do not have already obtained oral evaluations during the course** (who do have to take the oral exam), the email with the result of the written exam will also contain the link to connect with the online room to take the oral exam and the time of the exam.
- The oral exam will be based on the topics of the e-learning platform and will last 20 minutes.
- A no-show to the oral exam will entail the forfeiture of the result of the written exam, which has to be repeated.
